EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

DNA Penalty Assessment:

Per Government Code Section 76104.6, added by Proposition 69 (November 2, 2004 General Election), an additional penalty of one dollar for every ten dollars (\$10) of base fine, or fraction thereof, shall be levied on every fine, penalty, or forfeiture collected for criminal offense including Vehicle Code violations except parking offenses. This is in addition to any other penalty assessments that are currently included in the total fine. The money collected under this code section will be used to defray the costs of DNA Identification.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2005

Santa Barbara County Emergency Medical Service Assessment:

- 1) Per Government Code Section 76104.1(a), added by Senate Bill 635, a penalty of five dollars (\$5) for every ten dollars (\$10) of base fine, or fraction thereof, shall be imposed on every fine, penalty, or forfeiture collected for criminal offenses including Vehicle Code violations *except parking offenses*. This is in addition to any other penalty assessments that are currently included in the total fine.
- 2) Per Government Code Section 76104.1(b), added by Senate Bill 635, for *every parking offense* where a parking penalty, fine, or forfeiture is imposed, an added penalty of two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) shall be included in the total penalty, fine, or forfeiture. This is in addition to any other penalty assessments that are currently included in the total fine.

The money collected under this code section will be used to establish an Emergency Medical Service Fund in the County of Santa Barbara. This code section will remain in effect until January 1, 2007 unless a later statute extends this date.
